Special Interest Groups (SIG)

IFICs Special Interest Groups (SIGs) are global forums set up by IFIC members to bring people together to exchange and share knowledge in support of developing sustainable high quality person centred integrated care.

By joining a SIG you will receive email updates on SIG activities including addition of new resources and you can submit your own resources for sharing. You can create discussion forums and ask questions of your globally connected community.

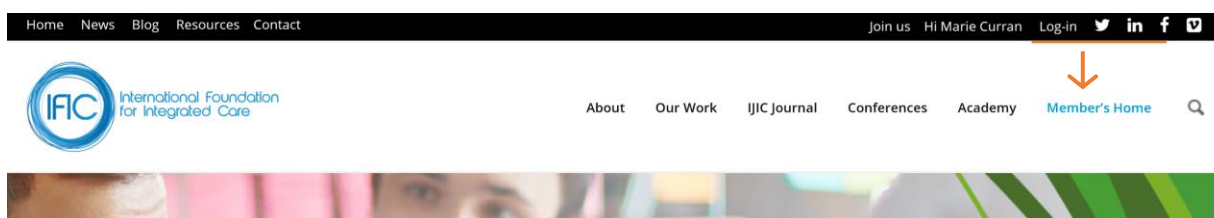
Join the movement – stay connected

STEP 1: Join IFIC – you will be joining a global community united and passionate about integrated care and integration.
