- give your insight into focus groups analysis.



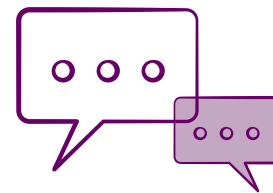
You will have a direct role in gathering the information that will inform the transformation of cancer care services in Scotland.
